New Ticketable Offences Under the OHSA

The Provincial Offences Act was recently updated to provide Ministry of Labour inspectors the ability to issue tickets within workplaces for certain offences under the OHSA and the Health and Safety Awareness & Training Regulation (O. Reg. 297/13). These tickets can carry a fine of \$550 per offence. Learn more below.
