

#### Does it fit? Research into paramedic PPE

Researchers from the University of Toronto and Ontario Health are looking at how respirators fit during intense paramedic tasks such as performing CPR or lifting patients. And they need volunteers.

Volunteers will be given an anonymous, simulated fit test. They will also have an opportunity to provide their thoughts, concerns, and improvement suggestions to researchers.

The data from the research will be compared against the Canadian Standard Association's respirator fit standards. It will also be used to help shape future policy decisions.



#### WSIB 2023 premium rates

The average premium rate for Ontario businesses in 2023 remains steady at \$1.30 per \$100 of insurable payroll, the lowest it has been in more than twenty years.

Starting in January 2023, the WSIB will no longer mail paper statements of account, premium rate statements or claim detail statements. Your WSIB account statements will be available exclusively through their online services.

#### JHSC Refresher - Distance Learning


Do you need to complete a JHSC Refresher course in the new year? We've got you covered!

- The RACE method for recognizing, assessing and controlling health and safety hazards, and evaluating hazard controls with the Hazard Management Tool
