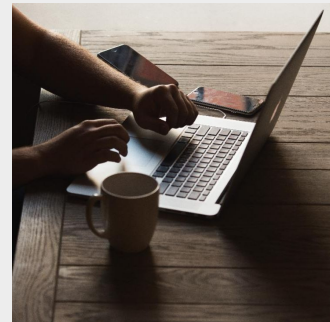

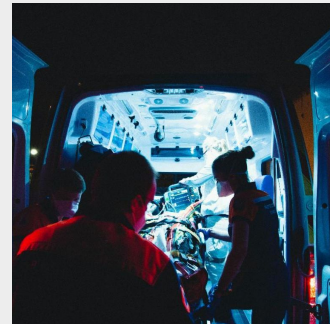

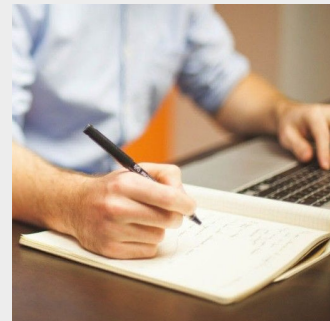
Participants will complete standard and modified fit testing. They will also be able to provide their thoughts, concerns, and improvement suggestions to researchers.

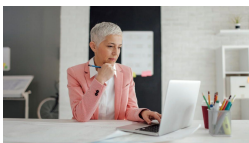
